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Book Three – The Company Docket

Filings that trained CLINAMEN-Chat – regenerated live from the bureau-company-filings dataset. 36 companies, one filing each, own-voice; roster live-verified.

SPACE

Astranis

San Francisco maker of small (~600 kg) MicroGEO geostationary broadband communications satellites dedicated to a single customer/region, including its larger next-gen Omega line.

FILING BIS-F / Zone 7::2 (syzygy 7::2, Sine + Cosine). Filed against the first Oceania operator ordering a full constellation block of Astranis-type microsatellites: ANZCOMMUNICATIONS, having ordered its Block D fleet as part of the Australian National Broadband Network program, files when it achieves commissioning readiness for the whole constellation across two launches scheduled within calendar year-end. The swerve is that a national carrier has bought enough capacity at once to be measured by the constellation rather than the tower. Resolution via AU-NBN/NBN Co operations disclosures and the operator's FCC filings.

SWERVE: A national infrastructure purchase becomes a constellation-in-the-making, and the regulator must name the constellation before naming the towers.

TOWER: Australia's NBN (now AU-NBN) will have announced full satellite availability.

AstroForge

Southern California asteroid-mining startup aiming to extract and refine platinum-group metals from metallic near-Earth asteroids (\$55M raised, incl. a \$40M Series A).

The Bureau notes that by January 1, 2030, AstroForge has received its first payment-in-kind into the corporate treasury, settled via a sovereign-central bank digital-currency settlement channel specified in the operator's quarterly disclosure. The transfer amount exceeds \$1 million in value and settles through a correspondent banking relationship explicitly permitted under the Federal Reserve's foreign-currency program. Resolution

rests with the operator's published quarterly disclosures and the central bank settlement record.

Blue Origin

Jeff Bezos's space company; suborbital New Shepard, orbital heavy-lift New Glenn (currently grounded), and Blue Moon lunar landers serving NASA's Artemis Human Landing System and moon-base program.

The last of three RS-25 engines powering Blue Origin's Space Launch System stage ignites aboard a launch vehicle no longer under development – the final operational booster of the SLS configuration that carried Orion into orbit and beyond. The engine vendor confirms shipment completion and end-of-life retirement; the operator files its final propellant drawdown notice. A single combustion chamber lives as long as four flights across two decades before it ends quietly in a tank.

Firefly Aerospace

Publicly traded (Nasdaq: FLY, IPO Aug 2025 at ~\$6.6B) launch and lunar company; Alpha small-launch rocket and Blue Ghost lunar landers, plus defense/space-tech work.

A Firefly Aerospace mission logs a controlled descent over populated ocean waters before 31 December 2027 – recovery crews aboard helicopters arriving within minutes after the vehicle enters visual range, then boarding the stricken spacecraft to salvage payload modules. The operator publishes the rescue event as a technical bulletin. Resolution against FAA Surface Movement Operations records and NASA Spaceflight recovery reports.

Impulse Space

Redondo Beach, CA in-space mobility company (founded by ex-SpaceX propulsion lead Tom Mueller) building orbital transfer vehicles: the Mira precision-maneuvering spacecraft and the Helios high-energy kick stage.

An Impulse Space vehicle delivers propellant to a stranded CubeSat at low Earth orbit, using a heliocentric rendezvous maneuver that closes within half a day's worth of fuel before refilling begins. The payload owner files commissioning and the FCC grant. Resolution via FAA launch authorization records and Space-Track decay notifications.

Interlune

Seattle lunar-resources startup (ex-Blue Origin team) developing SUV-sized robotic harvesters to extract helium-3 from lunar regolith and return it to Earth, primarily for superconducting quantum-computing applications.

Interlune's first revenue will come from a moon that does not yet exist: the sale of a fractionated sample of cold-trap helium-3 to a customer who cannot afford the full supply of 188 grams per launch window. The firm files the shipment as inventory under its 188-gram catalog number and records revenue at the atomic weight – precisely what no regulator will permit because nobody was there when they wrote the rules. Resolution: Interlune Q3 2028 revenue disclosure, SEC filings, and the USGS export statistics database. A molecule traded by mass rather than by price, and thus untradable.

FILING 5::4/LM-04. Subject: First commercial payload lofted by RocketLab's Neutron demonstration vehicle above 150 km altitude, filed as a Space-Track catalog entry with a non-zero conjunction risk window at perigee. The Bureau notes that low-orbit reentry remains the only acceptable endpoint here – every mission below this height will burn before it can be measured. Resolution via Space-Track conjunction warning and FCC orbital debris program filings. Swerve is minimal because the threshold exists already under another name. Near-certainty.

Sierra Space

Private space company building the Dream Chaser reusable cargo spaceplane and inflatable LIFE habitat modules (supplied to the Blue Origin-led Orbital Reef commercial station).

The Sierra Aerospace Flight Development Center's ten-month Dream Chaser mission-acquisition program ends with an uncrewed Pathfinder demonstration crossing Mach 2 at hypersonic cruise before settling into a routine operational fleet. The first Pathfinder will carry no crew and will return without a crew either – only cargo that must be delivered. Resolution via FAA Part 457 certification filings and the operator's published fleet-scope listing. Swerve filed under runway length: every subsequent orbital demonstrator carries more than it could have carried as a manned freighter.

Resolution via the FCC Satellite Log record.

Kent, WA developer of the fully and rapidly reusable medium-lift Nova rocket, whose second stage uses a regeneratively-cooled metallic heat shield with a ring of thrusters instead of an ablative TPS.

Form STX-SFC-0001 closes: by year-end 2028 the SpaceX Falcon Heavy reusability rate climbs

The event settles in NASA's Commercial Orbital Transportation Services program data and Space Systems Loral's mission disclosure filings. Stoke Space watches this as its own operational benchmark. Resolution via NASA-COTS reuse-rate reporting and Space Systems Loral disclosure.

The first human subject treated at Varda's New Mexico clinical site receives a microgravity-dosed formulation administered during a controlled descent into the Atlantic Ocean. The dose is small enough that it could have been done before anyone knew who would take it.

Long Beach, CA commercial space-station developer building Haven-1, slated to be the world's first commercial space station, plus the larger multi-module Haven follow-on.

VAST files a preliminary construction contract with the US FAA, naming Haven-1 as the facility it will certify under Part 41 subpart D-20, the same part that has held no manned vehicle since Apollo. The FCC license accompanying the award carries a Class III operation note – high-power microwave transmitter over a populated area – which FAA staff must sign off upon before certifying anything. The Bureau records that the US Department of Energy enters a contract award notice for Commonwealth Fusion's ARC demonstration reactor at a Virginia power station, committing a specific amount toward spurring construction. The award number carries a schedule and a delivery clause naming the facility. A contractor named in that procurement becomes the litigant you will find referenced across the filings – the entity holding money against its own completion. The DOE award notice is the focal point of this dockets' single event: who will pay to make it happen.

Helion Energy

Filed against Orion's first grid-connected metered year-end. Resolution: quarterly EIA retail sales report and Helion Q4 2028 revenue disclosure. Swerve: the company files its income statement as energy, not electrons, before anyone can read them. Consequence runs through the metering cycle and beyond.

Pacific Fusion

FILING 6::3/PACF-04. The Pacific Fusion collaboration's first-year report will cite an

This is the key threshold: no reconfiguration, just holding the magnetic-field envelope steady through every joule, which makes scaling possible. Resolution via arXiv preprint(s) + peer-reviewed journal paper. Filed against the geometry that keeps the stars warm.

Beam-driven field-reversed-configuration fusion targeting aneutronic hydrogen-boron (p-B11) fuel; currently independent but with a pending all-stock ~\$6B merger with Trump Media (Nasdaq: DJT), announced Dec 2025 and targeted to close by Q4 2026, which would take it public.

The filing cites the IAEA safety report number and states that the facility will be operated by the Advanced Fusion Systems consortium as an experimental demonstrator until further notice. Anduril Industries

Palmer Luckey-founded autonomous-defense company: Lattice AI command-and-control software, Ghost/Ghost Shark uncrewed systems, Bolt-M and Fury drones, and counter-UAS hardware.

FILING BIS-F / Zone 4 (Zone 4's dark center): By December 2027, Anduril's first production unit will complete its initial operational test series and be certified as a combat vehicle by the US Army under DoD 868. The Resolution Source is the DoD ODTM final report certifying a weapon system and the operator's acquisition award record identifying the entity selected to meet it. Swerve: the certification that closes this entry is the moment when a defense contractor receives a live mission from a field army rather than a desk. Filed against the DoD Acquisition Report and the operator's contract awards.

Castelion

California (El Segundo/Torrance) defense startup founded by ex-SpaceX engineers, building low-cost, mass-manufacturable hypersonic strike weapons – flagship 'Blackbeard' – with vertically integrated production and a high-cadence in-house flight-test program.

FILING BIS-F / Zone 3 (Torrance, CA).

Zone 3 files under manufacture. The Bureau observes that at no point will Castelion produce a single weapon – it makes platforms, not projectiles. What moves across the threshold is volume: a fleet of missiles rolled off a line rather than built by hand for each mission, which is where every other manufacturer loses money before it ever flies.

Saronic

Austin, TX defense-tech company designing and mass-manufacturing autonomous surface vessels (USVs) – from the 24-ft Corsair to the 180-ft Marauder MUSV – for the U.S. Navy and allies, with an autonomy-first, vertically integrated shipbuilding model.

FILING BIS-SAF/203. Filed under Saronic, Texas. The Bureau records that a commissioned Saronic vessel has logged more than three hundred hours underway without being ordered off station, proving it can survive an extended sea day while maintaining full autonomy above thirty knots – no human crew aboard, no onboard maintenance performed. Resolution rests with the Navy's operational disclosure documenting sustained independent operation beyond forty-eight hours. Swerve filed against the horizon where an unmanned vehicle proves capable of enduring away from a control tower longer than its own engineers imagined. Status pending.

Shield AI

San Diego defense-autonomy company: Hivemind AI 'pilot' software and the V-BAT VTOL drone (plus the new jet-powered X-BAT); Hivemind is the autonomy provider for Anduril's Fury under the Air Force CCA program.

MANUFACTURING

Hadrian

AI-powered precision-manufacturing company (Hadrian Automation Inc., Torrance, CA) building and operating automated 'smart' factories that machine parts for U.S. aerospace, defense and maritime supply chains; plants

in Mesa, AZ and Cherokee, AL.

FILING BIS-F / HADRIAN-AUTOMATION. A California state-compliance certificate attesting that the Tennessee Valley Authority's Hadrian facility has installed and validated its emergency-power override logic – a manual override path through all safety interlocks that can be called from off-site during grid outages – will resolve against TVA compliance records and the operator's public disclosures. The Bureau notes this is a human-maintained door closing behind a machine: an override path exists only because someone was willing to stand between the machine and a shutdown order. Filed pending a state utility commission record and the operator's SEC disclosure.

COMPUTE

Cerebras Systems

Builds wafer-scale AI processors (Wafer Scale Engine 3 / CS-3 systems) and a high-speed inference cloud; now publicly traded (Nasdaq: CBRN) after its May 2026 IPO – still an independent company, not acquired.

The Bureau records that a Cerebras Wafer Scale Engine 3 system completes a year of sustained throughput above ten trillion operations per second without human intervention – the first machine certified as autonomous during continuous operation at full load, rather than supervised during test intervals. The verification window closes when the disclosed sustained-throughput figure crosses this threshold, which resolves against the company's quarterly disclosure and SEC filings. Consequence: the world stops asking whether a supercomputer exists merely because someone built one quietly enough no one had time to notice.

FILING BIS-F / Zone 3 (Pilot). Filed under Transformer Only: A single customer's production network runs entirely on Etched TPU chips across the entire inference pipeline, while every upstream model it calls depends only on the transformer subarchitecture that Etched built into silicon. The event: first quarter of calendar year 2027, reported through Semiconductors & Supply Chains quarterly review. Resolution via SEMI industry data sheets and the company's disclosed manufacturing commitments. Swerve logged against the pilot: a node designed to be fast at a narrow task quietly becomes the fastest tool available for a very specific kind of problem, and no competitor has yet caught up.

Groq

AI inference company running GroqCloud, a global LPU-powered inference cloud (13 data centers, 5M+ developers, trillions of tokens/week); after Nvidia non-exclusively licensed its LPU chip IP for ~\$20B and hired founder Jonathan Ross (Dec 2025), Groq re-centered on the inference-as-a-service/neocloud business rather than selling its own chips.

The first month Groq's revenue accrues against its net income exceeds 4% of total revenues. The auditor's note discloses the percentage as "net of deferred tax" and explains that the loss carryforward will be exhausted before any profit can appear. This number exists only because the company was allowed to take losses into account before it could earn them. Resolution rests with the quarterly SEC filings and the accompanying auditors' notes.

Tenstorrent

Independent AI-chip company led by Jim Keller building open RISC-V CPUs and Tensix AI accelerators; current-gen Blackhole processors and Galaxy multi-chip systems (earlier Grayskull retired, Wormhole prior-gen, Quasar chiplets on roadmap). Reportedly in Qualcomm acquisition talks (\$8-10B) as of mid-2026, but no deal announced -- still independent.

The first Tenstorrent processor leaves a data center through a DCIM vendor's rack-mount enclosure listing, carrying sustained throughput above the PetaSpeed benchmark it claims it has beaten. The number survives the vendor's own disclosure note without correction.

Resolution: RackWorld.com listings + the corresponding datasheet published in OpenWhisk/NIST IRG format. Swerve filed across the last two quarters – the claim had been quietly waiting behind closed doors, and now it appears fully dressed before anyone was watching.

Figure

Builds general-purpose humanoid robots (current gen Figure 03) powered by its in-house Helix vision-language-action model (Helix 02); moving from pilots to industrial deployment, most visibly on BMW production/logistics lines.

Filed against BMW's Spartanburg plant: Figure 03 will move beyond demonstrator into fielded operation on a production line as part of a Helix-powered humanoid pilot program, logged under the vehicle group rather than robotics, with resolution through the German Federal Inspectorate inspection reports published annually. The deviation is minimal – the machine enters a manufacturing cell where no robot has walked before – yet it changes nothing. Filed pending the inspectorate's annual report certifying that a figure did something productive.
